Cultural

- Girdling roots caused by improper planting.
- Lawn mower/ weed whipper damage
- Improper use of mulch (donut NOT volcano)
- Root flare should be evident

Diseases

- Mushrooms growing on bark indicate rotting taking place under the bark.
- Cankers enter through wounds.
- Leaf blights are usually cosmetic issues.
- Verticillium wilt mainly a problem on maples and catalpa trees. Less often - barberry and basswood.
 Evergreens aren't bothered by this pathogen.

Pests

- Gall mites are small bumps on the leaf usually red or green. These are caused by an insect and are usually cosmetic. Only becomes a problem if the tree is heavily
- infested year after year and has other stress factors.
- Insects are only an issue if they're in large numbers and for a long period of time.

Physiological

- Fruits/nut not produced in mass every year.
- Growing stress not evident that year, sometimes it's 2-3 years after the initial stress event
- Chlorosis -nutrient deficiency
- ♥ Slim flux

- Thinning crown is a sign tree is having a hard time getting water to the top
- What to look for to determine a tree in stress versus. "normal" behavior (shedding, drooping branches, etc.)
